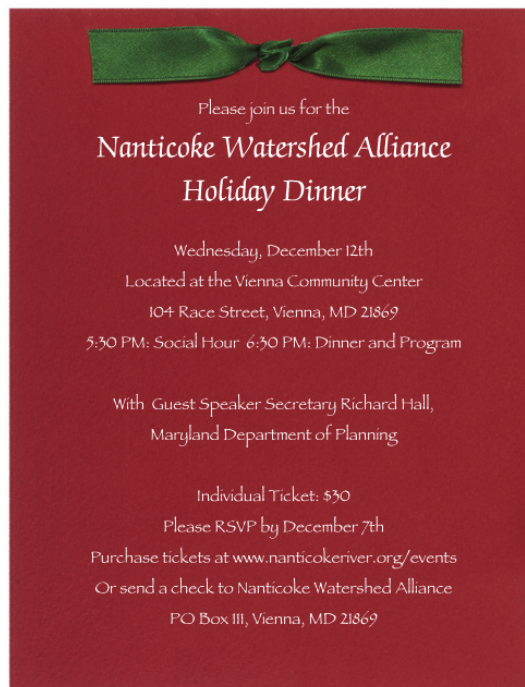
## Potluck and Governor's Award Photos
