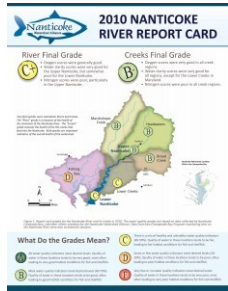




Join the Nanticoke Creekwatchers Citizen Water Monitoring Volunteer Corps in 2012
