The first sampling period was a little bumpy, as to be expected with the new protocol this year. I've listed a few things to keep in mind to help make Sampling Period 2 run smoother and that will help maintain the integrity of your data and samples.

1. Please make sure that you record the volume of water filtered through the chlorophyll a filter on BOTH the foil (NOT on the ziplocks) and on the BACK of the SUPPLEMENTAL form. There were several foils that did not include this information, which meant we had to open both of the ziplocks (a couple of which promptly split along the seams) and record this information for you.
