Black Gum ● White Oak

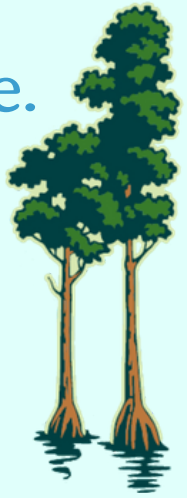


Native Tree List

Find the tree that's right for your home.

Check the sun exposure, soil moisture, and amount of space available for the full-grown tree. Then, choose trees from our list that will grow and thrive in those conditions. It's extremely important to understand how large these trees will grown before you plant them. Since we are using native species that thrive in this region, there should be no need for fertilizer.

* Trees are currently about 2 feet tall and will come in either a 1 or 3 gallon pot*
